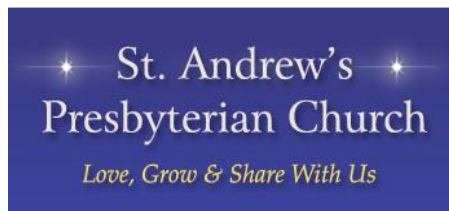

NEW - REMEDIAL CASE TRIAL RESULTS IN DECISION IN FAVOR OF ST. ANDREW'S AND INDIVIDUAL COMPLAINANTS. On November 10, 2012, after hearing trial testimony and considering all the evidence, the *Permanent Judicial Commission of the Synod of Southern California and Hawaii* (SPJC) issued a decision and rulings in favor of complainants, including St. Andrew's Session, several teaching and ruling elders and against the Presbytery of Santa Barbara on 18 of 19 Counts. The SPJC overturned the actions taken related to the union presbytery plan with ECO adopted by the Presbytery on June 2.
