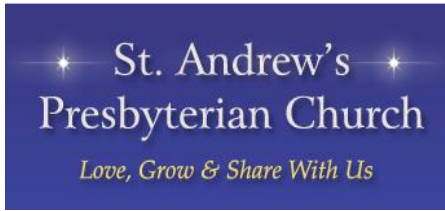

**PET NEWS.** The Property Exploration Team (PET) has continued in recent weeks to review and negotiate terms of an offer from The Oak Creek Company to purchase and subdivide approximately 1 acre of vacant church land. At its meeting on October 15, Session approved and accepted the terms of a written Purchase Agreement which includes conditions for Congregational and Presbytery approval. A second Congregational Informational Meeting (not a formal vote) is scheduled for Sunday, November 24th at 11:15AM in the Sanctuary. Jeff Nelson and Jason Nelson from The Oak Creek Company will be present along with the PET to provide information and answer questions.
