INVITATION TO THE LORD’S TABLE *responsive*

MINISTER: Friends, this is the joyful feast of the people of God!

MINISTER: According to Luke, when our risen Lord was at table with his disciples, he took the bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to them, just as we, ministering in his name, now give it to you. And when the disciples received it, their eyes were opened and they recognized Jesus!
